

English:

Children will be creating a narrative piece linking to the book 'Stone Age Boy'. They will also create a poetic piece inspired by the title 'Autumn is here.' After half term we will be creating a non-fiction piece in the form of a newspaper report based on the 'Wizard of Once' tales by Cressida Cowell.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar:

Children will continue to follow the Oxford Owl Spelling scheme and will have daily practise at spelling the common exception words for Year 3/4.

Guided Reading:

Children will be provided with a variety of different texts to support their reading fluency, recall of key facts and vocabulary and their ability to infer from what is happening in the text.

Home Learning:

Home learning will contain a Maths and an English piece of work. It will be handed out on a Wednesday to be returned on the following Monday.

As the weather is now changing, please ensure your child has a labelled jumper/cardigan and a coat. Please also make sure your child is wearing appropriate school footwear.

Maths:

Both year 3 and year 4 will begin the year by learning about place value. They will become confident with numbers up to 1000 (year 3) and 10,000 (year 4). They will practice adding and subtracting larger numbers and how to problem solve using addition and subtraction. To finish the autumn term, the children will explore the topic of multiplication and division.

Religious Education:

Our big questions we will be covering are: "How do people respond to the issues of poverty and justice?" and "What does it mean to be part of a global Christian Community?"

PSHE/RSHE:

This term, the children will be exploring the topics of:

Year 3: Healthy relationships and healthy lifestyle.

Year 4: Rights and responsibilities and valuing differences.

Physical Education:

This term, children will continue with Premier Education on a Tuesday and they will have Gymnastics on a Thursday.

Humanities:

This term, children will be discovering prehistoric Britain and how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. They will explore how these periods in time influenced modern technology and the tools used. We will make cross curricular links through the use of the nature area and through the form of art, DT and drama.

Science:

This term, children will be exploring the topic of Electricity. They will be looking at circuits and will have the opportunity to create their own looking at common insulators and conductors.

Art/DT:

Children will be creating their own cave paintings and will be making Bronze Age jewellery using clay.

Computing:

The children will be exploring the topics of computing systems and networks and creating media.
