ICT

We will be understanding the function of IT and learn how to paint digitally.

ENGLISH

Narrative – Year 1

Our English will follow our phonics and guided reading lessons which will be looking at books linked to our current phonics level.

Narrative- Year 2

Our English focus this half-term will be looking at fables and poems such as 'If I were in charge of the world' and 'The Crows Tale'.

Read Write Inc. Phonics/Spelling

Pupils will have daily phonics or spelling lessons teaching them strategies to help them spell more complicated words. The children will bring home Phonics/spelling homework each week, linked to the sounds they have been learning.

Guided Reading

Guided reading will be taught within the phonics lessons and will be supported by books in line with their phonic knowledge.

The main focus for this half term will be Superheroes. We will be naming our body parts, including our skeleton and exploring our 5 senses and exploring superheroes from the past

MATHS

Year 1

In Maths this half term children will be place value, addition and subtraction within ten and looking at geometry.

Year 2

In maths this half term we will be securing our knowledge of numbers up to twenty and beyond through place value. We will be learning about addition and subtraction and then learning about money.

RE

Our big question for this half term is 'Why is Christmas important to Christians?'

ART/DT

Children will be making skeletons and creating patterns using natural materials.

PSHE

The topic that we will be exploring in PSHE this term is –
Year 1 – 'What is the same and what is different about us?' and 'How do I become a good friend?'.
Year 2 - 'What am I good at?' and 'What is bullying?'

PE

Children will be specifically focusing on learning multi-skills (balancing, coordination and agility). They will also be exploring different types of movement and dance.

Music

In music we will be singing, learning about beat and rhythm and composing using percussion instruments.

SCIENCE – How does my skeleton support my body?

Children will be labelling different parts of the body, and learning how these work. We will investigate how our senses help us to learn about the world around us, and which part of the body we use to relate to each sense. We will be learning about the importance of exercise and healthy eating.

Topic – Was Edith Right to Break the Rules?

Children will be investigating superheroes and villains. What qualities they possess and thinking about their superhero qualities. We will then be looking at real life superheroes such as Edith Cavell and Mary Seacole and their achievement in nursing and medicine.
