ENGLISH

Narrative – Year 1

Our English will follow our phonics and guided reading lessons which will be looking at books linked to our current phonics level.

Narrative- Year 2

Our English focus this half-term will be looking at non-fiction and learning about Grace Darling and writing a non-chronological report about Singapore.

Read Write Inc. Phonics/Spelling

Pupils will have daily phonics or spelling lessons teaching them strategies to help them spell more complicated words. The children will bring home Phonics/spelling homework each week, linked to the sounds they have been learning.

Guided Reading

Guided reading will be taught within the phonics lessons and will be supported by books in line with their phonic knowledge.

Our Topic for this half term will be 'Coastlines'. We will be exploring our local coastline and comparing to others around the world. We will focus on geography, using maps and atlases to understand our world a little better.

MATHS

Year 1

In Maths this half term children will be place value within 20, addition and subtraction within twenty and looking at measurement.

Year 2

In maths this half term we will be learning about geometry, money, multiplication and division.

R.E

This term children will be exploring 2 big questions. What is right and what is wrong? Where we will be looking at the parable of The Good Samaritan and What might Jewish people learn from the story of Moses?

COMPUTING

The children will be learning basic skills on Microsoft word like typing, saving, printing and other features.

ART/DT

Children will be creating a piece of artwork based on the geography of Hopton and will be creating bug hotels.



PE

Children will participate in gymnastic lessons, which will involve an inter-key stage competition with Year 1 and 2. Children will also be working on multi-skill activities and teamwork.

MUSIC

Children will be exploring the different sounds from various habitats/ homes around the

GEOGRAPHY

We will be looking at different maps of Hopton through the ages and comparing them. We will also look at various maps of the county, country, UK and the world. We will be learning about atlases and their symbols too.

SCIENCE

Children will be exploring elements of a habitat. They will be learning about what animals and plants require to survive and how humans can have an impact on this. They will be learning about names of trees and plants. They will also be comparing the differences between things that are living, dead or never been alive.

PSHE

The topic that we will be exploring in PSHE this term is – Year 1 – 'How should we share our feelings?' and 'What are rules?'. Year 2 - 'What do I do if I feel uncomfortable?' and 'What are families like?'
